COVID-19 Vaccine and Treatment: Proper Coding Reminder

Dear Provider:

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Louisiana wants to remind providers to bill COVID-19 vaccines and treatments with the designated codes for each manufacturer.

Providers should not bill Blue Cross for CPT[®] and HCPCS codes 91300, 91301, Q0239, Q0243 and Q0245. The federal government covers these COVID-19 vaccines and drugs.

Some providers are not billing the correct code for the second vaccination. Properly billed COVID-19 vaccinations should include the first and second administration code.

Vaccines:

Administration costs for the vaccines listed below are eligible for Blue Cross payment when billed with the correct codes:

Vaccines	Code Guidelines
Pfizer	• 91300 – vaccine
	 0001A – first administration
	 0002A – second administration
Moderna	• 91301 – vaccine
	 0011A – first administration
	0012A – second administration

Antibody Treatments:

Administration costs for the drugs listed below are eligible for Blue Cross payment when billed with the correct codes:

Monoclonal Antibody	Code Guidelines
Lilly (bamlanivimab)	• Q0239 – drug
	 M0239 – infusion and monitoring
Regeneron	• Q0243 – drug
	 M0243 – infusion and monitoring
Lilly (bamlanivimab & etesevimab)	• Q0245 – drug
	 M0245 – infusion and monitoring

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Blue Cross will update providers on proper billing guidelines as more COVID-19 vaccines and treatments become available.
